

Hawaii is the most expensive state to live in the US!

Over 11,200 struggling families with children are working 2 jobs.

WHY THE NEED FOR AN AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM:

► Education Concern:

- ▶ 57% of students scored at proficient level for math
- ▶61% scored at level for reading.

▶ DOE Concern:
