- 1. Over 25% of elderly Americans are socially isolated.**
- 2. Nearly 46% of elderly still do not use online banking and shopping.**
- 3. Last year in Hawaii, 470 seniors reported being scammed out of \$11.5 million.**

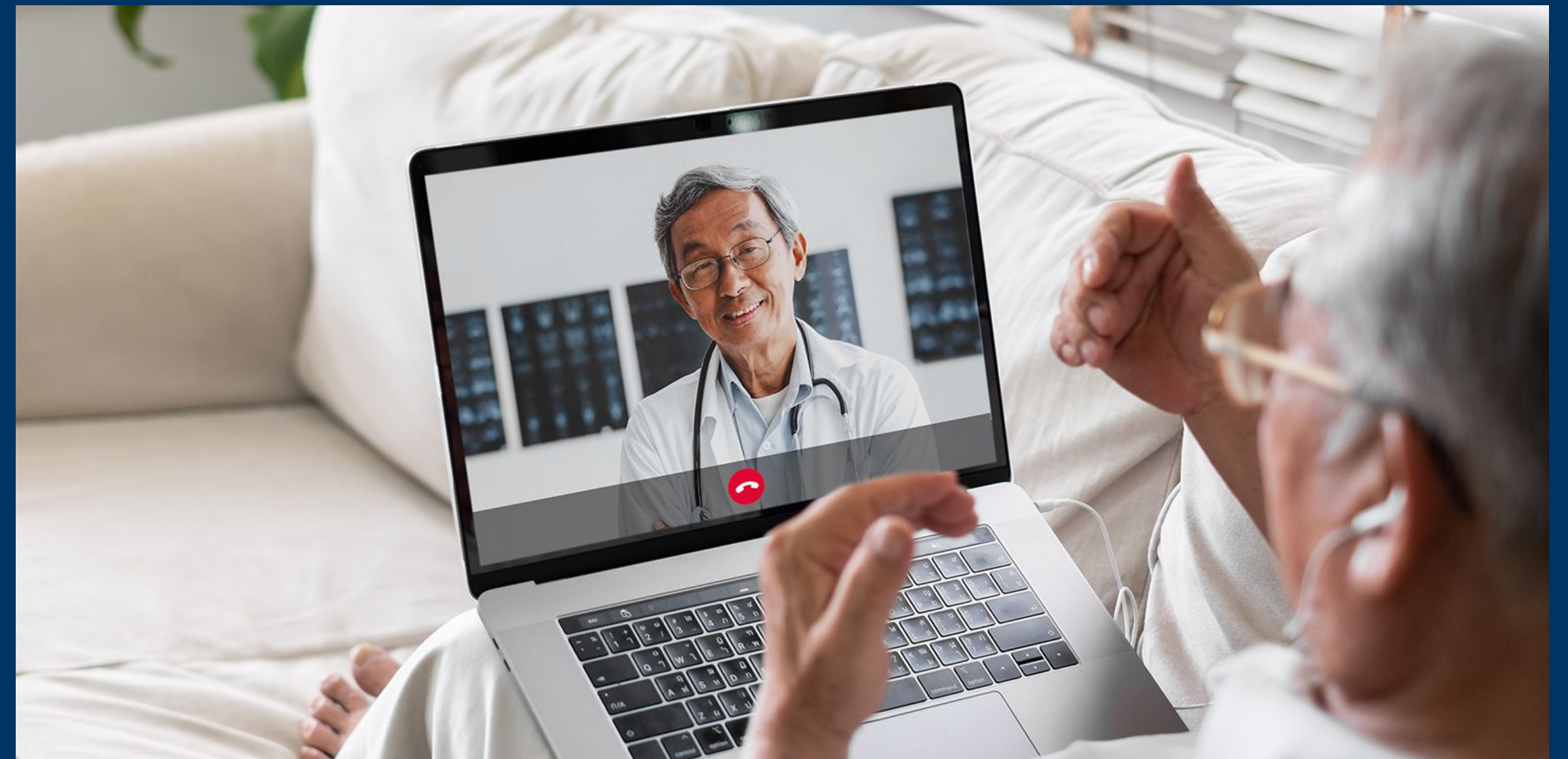




# A little TLC can go a long way.
